## Ramp closures scheduled in Topeka tonight, overnight tomorrow

Temporary ramp closures are scheduled to occur tonight and overnight tomorrow as part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's resurfacing project on I-70 in Topeka. Motorists should plan for the following:

Tonight, Sept. 11, from approximately 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.:

- The westbound I-70 exit ramp to eastbound I-470 will be closed. A marked detour will direct motorists to Auburn Road, to eastbound I-70, to the eastbound I-470 exit.

Tomorrow, Sept. 12, from 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. on Friday, Sept. 13:

- The Wanamaker Road entrance ramp onto eastbound I-70 will be closed. A marked detour will direct motorists to westbound I-70, to Auburn Road, to eastbound I-70.
- The eastbound I-70 exit ramp to Fairlawn Road will be closed. A marked detour will direct motorists to Gage Boulevard, to westbound I-70, to Fairlawn Road.

Drivers can follow the marked detours or use alternate routes. Message boards and signage will be in place to alert and direct motorists.
