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Guardrail replacement project to start on U.S. 166

On Wednesday, Nov. 13, the Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin a guardrail replacement project on U.S. 166 in Montgomery County. Guardrail will be replaced 0.71 mile east of the Chautauqua/Montgomery county line, and 0.07 mile east of U.S. 75.

Temporary signals will direct one-lane traffic through the work zones; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by mid-March 2025.

KDOT awarded B & B Bridge Co., St. Paul, the \$480,116 construction contract. KDOT urges motorists to stay alert and follow posted signs in all work zones.
