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## KDOT to resurface U.S. 160 east of Oswego

Tuesday, Sept. 3, the Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin resurfacing work on U.S. 160. The work will begin at the east city limits of Oswego and continue east for almost 15 miles, ending at the junction with U.S. 69/K-7.

Project activity includes concrete repairs, milling with an ultrathin bonded asphalt overlay and pavement markings. Flaggers and a pilot car operation will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours. Expect delays of 15 minutes or less. The road work should be finished by mid-October, weather permitting.

KDOT awarded the construction contracts totaling \$2.1 million to Emery Sapp & Sons Inc. and Subsidiaries, Columbia, Missouri.
