KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

KDOT Current Projects

- 1. New: Entrance ramp from E Central Avenue and the exit 7B ramp to E 9th Street N of northbound I-135. The rehabilitation project will involve patching. Maintenance is set to conclude in late July.
- Northbound I-135 from 2nd Street to 17th Street will have the *right lane* closed Monday, June 17. The rehabilitation project will involve patching. Maintenance is set to conclude in early November.
- 3. Westbound/eastbound U.S. 400 between 159th Street and Prairie Creek Road is conducting a *geological field survey* Monday, June 17. The study will gather information needed for the proposed East Kellogg Expansion Project and expected to be **completed by early December**.
- 4. N East 45th street bridge over I-135 will have the westbound lane closed Monday, June 17. Maintenance is set to conclude in early October.
- 5. Westbound/eastbound U.S. 400 between K-96 and S Andover Road is conducting a geological field survey. The study will gather information needed for the proposed East Kellogg Expansion Project and expected to be completed by August.
- 6. I-135 northbound ramp to westbound U.S. 54 will have a ramp closure on Wednesday, June 5. The rehabilitation project will involve milling, patching and a concrete overlay being placed on each side consecutively. Maintenance is set to conclude in early August.

- 7. Westbound U.S. 54 to southbound Eisenhower Airport Parkway will have a bridge closure. The rehabilitation project will involve painting the bridge rail, deck drain cleaning and additional standard repairs. Maintenance is set to conclude in early July.
- 8. Update: Eastbound/westbound E 37th Street N from N Hydraulic Street to N Ohio Street. The *road closure* was for milling, patching and an asphalt overlay project. Reconstruction is now complete.
- 9. NB I-135 entrance from E 85th St N. will have the *ramp closed*, and NB I-135 between 77th Street and 101st Street will have the *lane closure* due to bridge construction work. Bridge reconstruction will be until Friday, September 27.

KDOT Multi-year Projects

- 1. Gold Project Phase 2B: North Junction to I-135/K-96 Interchange on I-135 and K-96 Construction began Feb. 6, 2023, with completion currently slated for late 2026. This phase includes a direct link for eastbound K-96 from northbound I-235 and southbound I-135, new westbound K-96 ramps to I-135 and other new ramps at K-96 and I-135 interchange.
 - A long-term 11-foot width restriction on the two lanes of southbound I-135, south of the I-235/K-254 overpass, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).
 - Southbound I-135 exit to eastbound K-96 has an 11-foot width restriction. Started March 8, 2023. Long-term Width Restriction
- Concrete pavement patching on I-235 from the South Junction with I-135 to N.
 Meridian began April 23. Work hours are Sundays 1 p.m. to 6 a.m. Mondays Thursdays 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- A City of Goddard project to construct a U.S. 54 RCUT (Restricted Crossing U-Turn Intersection) https://www.fhwa.dot.gov/publications/research/safety/09059/ began Sept. 5. The new intersection of U.S. 54 at Crown Drive/Barber Street includes turn lanes and traffic signalization.
 - Expect single-lane traffic for both directions of U.S. 54 through the east side of Goddard.
- 4. A Sedgwick County bridge repair project on Zoo Boulevard over the Mitch Mitchell Floodway began Sept. 11. The traffic lights are now operational, with ongoing construction in the median. Two lanes for eastbound and westbound traffic are now open on opposite sides of the median.
- 5. K-96 Improvements Project, upgrading the K-96 corridor between I-135 and I-35.
