U.S. 75 flyover to temporarily close on Monday

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to temporarily close a U.S. 75 flyover bridge in Topeka next week, as part of its ongoing bridge repair project.


Conditions permitting, **the southbound U.S. 75 flyover bridge to eastbound I-70/Gage Boulevard will be closed to traffic on Monday, Dec. 16, from approximately 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.** while concrete overlay is placed.

A marked detour will direct motorists to westbound I-70, Fairlawn Road, back to eastbound I-70 during the closure.

Drivers can follow the marked detour or use alternate routes. Message boards and signage will be in place to alert and direct motorists.
