KDOT to host open house for U.S. 24 bridge project in Topeka

The Kansas Department of Transportation will host an open house to provide information on proposed improvements for the U.S. 24 bridges over Goodyear Road in north Topeka. The public is invited to attend the meeting on Wednesday, Nov. 13, from 5 to 7 p.m., at The Brownstone, 4020 N.W. 25th Street, in Topeka.

Attendees will be able to review the proposed improvements, provide input and speak one-on-one with project staff. There will be no formal presentation, and attendees can come and go at any time during the meeting. Materials presented at the meeting will be available online at: ike.ksdot.gov/us24-bridges-goodyear-road.

KDOT is in the early design phase of this project, which will replace the eastbound and westbound U.S. 24 bridges over Goodyear Road in Topeka. The project is tentatively anticipated to begin in fall 2025.

The open house will also include information on current and upcoming projects in the area, including the U.S. 24 reconstruction, Stover Road bridges over U.S. 24 and the I-70 Polk-Quincy Viaduct projects.
