U.S. 169 passing lane survey to start in Allen and Anderson counties

The week of Aug. 12, Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin a survey for passing lanes on U.S. 169. The survey area starts south of West Virginia Road in Allen County and continues north to SW 300 Road in Anderson County.

Surveyors will gather the information necessary for a detailed design of the proposed improvement. The approximate length of the survey is 3.3 miles on the existing highway alignment. Weather permitting, the survey should be finished by Oct. 4.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. Joe Bowen of KDOT will manage the survey.
