## Portion of Nighthawk Road to close in Wallace County

A portion of Nighthawk Road in Wallace County will close to traffic as part of the Kansas Department of Transportation project to replace the U.S. 40 bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad west of Wallace.

Starting the week of July 1, Nighthawk Road will close at its junction with County Road 24. The closure is necessary for the construction of new pavement tie-ins to connect the finished bridge to U.S. 40.

The closure is expected to last through May 2025.
