Survey for guardrail improvements to begin at Mound City

The Kansas Department of Transportation expects the week of July 22 to begin a survey for guardrail improvements on K-52 in Mound City. The survey area is northeast of 2nd Street.

Surveyors will gather information necessary for a detailed design of the proposed improvements. The approximate length of the survey is 1,500 feet on the existing highway alignment. Weather permitting, the survey should be completed by Aug. 16.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. Brian Westberg of BG Consultants will manage the survey for KDOT.
