K-99 intersection to close Monday in Wabaunsee County

On Monday, July 8, Paw Paw Creek Road in Wabaunsee County will close at the intersection of K-99, as part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's ongoing realignment project.

The intersection is expected to be closed until early October, conditions permitting, while a new connection to the highway is constructed.

Access to Paw Paw Creek Road can be made via McFarland Road from I-70 or Homestead Road. No signed detours will be posted.
