Eastbound, westbound K-96 lane closures starting Sept. 11

On Wednesday, Sept. 11, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin intermittently closing lanes of eastbound, westbound K-96 from Maize to I-235 in Wichita.

The lane closures are necessary for a project that will involve milling, patching and hot mixed asphalt overlay. Work will occur Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.


It is estimated reconstruction will conclude in early November, conditions permitting.

During construction, sections of the highway will be reduced to one lane. The speed limit will be reduced to 60 mph in the work zone.

The map below outlines the project area.

Pearson Construction, of Wichita, is the primary contractor for the \$3,805,812 project.
