## Field survey to begin for guardrail improvements in Ellsworth County

Beginning Monday, Sept. 30, the Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin a field survey to gather information necessary for proposed guardrail improvements in Ellsworth County.

The proposed improvements would be located at the K-111/Avenue H junction, between K-156 and K-140. The length of the field survey will be about 1,500 feet, and the survey will be based on existing highway alignment.

Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property.

KDOT expects this survey to be completed by Oct. 28, 2024.
