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Survey for U.S. 160 shoulder improvements to begin in early December

The week of Dec. 2, the Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin a survey for shoulder improvements on U.S. 160, starting at the south junction with U.S. 169 and continuing east to Gartner Avenue in Altamont.

Surveyors will gather information necessary for a detailed design of the proposed improvement. The length of the survey is 16.2 miles on the existing highway alignment. Weather permitting, the survey should be completed by April 2025.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. John Lilak of Bartlet West will manage the survey for KDOT.
