I-70 ramp closure scheduled tonight in Topeka

An I-70 ramp in Topeka is scheduled to temporarily close tonight, Oct. 1, as part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's resurfacing project on I-70.

Conditions permitting, the westbound I-70 exit ramp to northbound U.S. 75 will be closed from approximately 6 p.m. to midnight, or until work is complete.

During the closure, a marked detour will direct motorists to Fairlawn Road, to eastbound I-70, to the northbound U.S. 75 exit.

Drivers can follow the marked detours or use alternate routes. Message boards and signage will be in place to alert and direct motorists.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of highway construction projects across Kansas, go to www.KanDrive.gov or call 5-1-1.
