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U.S. 75 bridge replacement project to start in October

Monday, Oct. 7, the Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin a project to replace the Cheyenne Creek bridge on U.S. 75. The bridge is one mile north of the U.S. 166/U.S. 75 south junction at Caney.

The bridge will be replaced one-half at a time. Traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by signals in the work zone area; expect brief delays. Weather permitting, the new bridge should be open in the autumn of 2025.

KDOT awarded the \$3.8 million construction contract to Bridges Inc., of Newton.
