Lane closures on I-135 and K-254 ramp closure for pavement repairs to shift Nov. 13

Starting Wednesday, Nov. 13, the Kansas Department of Transportation will shift ongoing pavement patching work on I-135 from the left lanes to the right lanes for both northbound and southbound traffic at the westbound K-254 crossing over I-135.


In addition, the K-254 exit ramp to northbound I-135 will close for approximately 10 days to facilitate repairs.

Work is scheduled during daytime hours, and drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly. Estimated completion is set for December, weather permitting.

During construction, the speed limit will be reduced to 50 mph in the work zone.
