KDOT construction projects affecting traffic

KDOT Current Projects

- New: Westbound K-96 ramps to I-135 and southbound I-135 ramp to eastbound K-96 will be closed starting Tuesday, Nov. 5. The nightly closures will occur from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. It is anticipated that work will conclude in early December.
- 2. New: Northbound and southbound I-135 lanes at the westbound K-254 crossing over I-135 will be closed starting Friday, Nov. 1. Estimated completion is set for December.
- New: Southbound I-235 ramp to northbound I-135 will be closed from Tuesday, Nov. 5 to Friday, Nov. 8. The closure is for partial-depth concrete repairs.
- 4. Update: Eastbound and westbound K-96 from Maize to I-235 will have intermittent lane closures starting Wednesday, Sept. 11. Maintenance has been completed.
- Westbound K-96 west of Hillside will have the inside lane closed starting Monday, Oct. 28. The closure will occur intermittently throughout the week to accommodate crane operations.
- 6. Seneca on-ramp to eastbound Kellogg will be closed for barrier wall repairs. The closure will take place on Tuesday, October 29 from approximately 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- 7. Westbound U.S. 54 exit ramp to southbound I-135 will close starting on Monday, Sept. 30. Motorists should follow the signed detour on northbound I-135 to exit 6B and 2nd Street, then turn left on southbound I-135 to the west Kellogg exit 6A. Work is expected to conclude by late December.
- 8. Eastbound U.S. 54 from Hillside Street to Webb Road will have the left and center lane closed starting on Sunday, August 4. The work will generally occur from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. When work is not occurring, the center lane will be reopened to the public. Maintenance is set to conclude in late December.
- 9. Westbound/eastbound U.S. 400 between 159th Street and Prairie Creek Road is conducting a geological field survey starting Monday, June 17. The study will gather information needed for the proposed East Kellogg Expansion Project and expected to be completed by early December.

KDOT Multi-year Projects

- 1. Gold Project Phase 2B: North Junction to I-135/K-96 Interchange on I-135 and K-96 Construction began Feb. 6, 2023, with completion currently slated for late 2026. This phase includes a direct link for eastbound K-96 from northbound I-235 and southbound I-135, new westbound K-96 ramps to I-135 and other new ramps at K-96 and I-135 interchange.
 - A long-term 11-foot width restriction on the two lanes of southbound I-135, south of the I-235/K-254 overpass, is in effect (along with a 50-mph work zone speed limit).
 - Southbound I-135 exit to eastbound K-96 has an 11-foot width restriction. Started March 8, 2023. Long-term Width Restriction
- Concrete pavement patching on I-235 from the South Junction with I-135 to N. Meridian began April 23. Work hours are Sundays 1 p.m. to 6 a.m. Mondays Thursdays 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- 3. K-96 Improvements Project, upgrading the K-96 corridor between I-135 and I-35.
