ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, Nebraska Department of Banking and Finance (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Getting paper copies
