REQUEST FOR PUBLIC HEARING

It is my belief that a Public Hearing should be conducted to address many technical questions regarding this application. The details involved in this change are highly technical issues involving air quality and water resources. A public hearing would answer many of these technician issues and ultimately require changes to the application.

Issues that need to be addressed are regarding air quality changes that would impact local air quality. Additionally, water utilization is a key issue here in the desert southwest, especially Arizona. A public hearing would permit comment from local and state water utilization authorities. A public hearing would bring additional information that would require changes to this application.

This power plant is on native american property, however, this power resource impacts non-tribal utilization, therefore a public hearing would be appropriate to ensure transparency. A forum that allows public input might influence a change in this application.
