



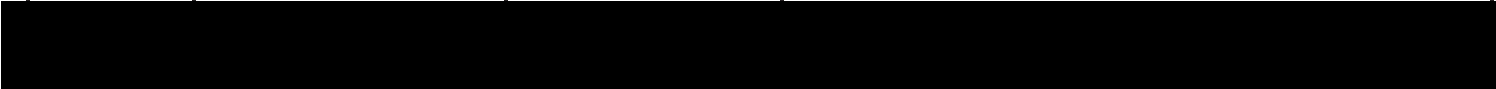



During the last inspection, July 2023 all the Bontebok on his property seen was clearly tagged an correlate to his exemption permit. There was no unmarked Bontebok found in the herds,

This bontebok herd is certified pure as indicated on the exemption permit and he is granted a hunting permit for 5 tested individuals.

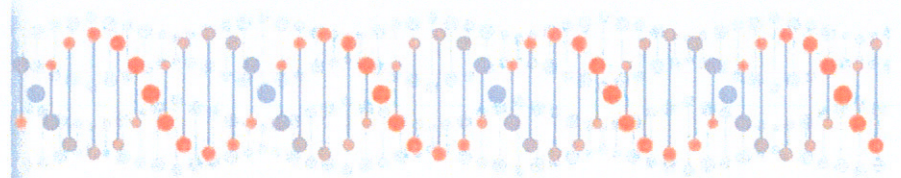
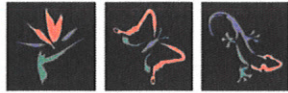
