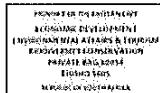

Herewith is the result of the 1 sample received for genetic testing of bontebok to detect hybrid animals. According to the DNA marker set typed, as compiled through research for the detection of possible hybrid animals the following results were obtained from an assignment test for bontebok and blesbok:

³ = Blesbok – 100% pure blesbok as determined by the nuclear test, using microsatellite markers.


