

RE: Direct Final Rule Changes



Attached to this note are 1) a list of changes from the direct final notice as signed to the direct final notice revised to conform to the <u>Federal Register</u> requirements, and 2) the direct final notice revised to reflect the list of changes. I also sent you, by fax, an example of a memo from the Division Director to the Assistant Administrator verifying that changes after signature are not substantive in nature, which you may use as a model for a similar memo in this case.

Changes to Direct Final Rule

"Dates" Section:

- 1. Move to "Supplementary Information" section all language except
 "If no adverse comments are received, the effective date of these
 revisions will be [insert 60 days from the date of publication of
 this notice]."
- 2. After "If no adverse comments are received," add "by [insert 30 days from the date of publication of this notice]."
- 3. After the first sentence, add "If the effective date is delayed, timely notice will be published in the <u>Federal Register</u>."

"Supplementary Information" section, as revised:

- 1. In the first sentence, substitute "EPA is proposing to revise" for "EPA has issued a notice that it is revising."
- 2. In the first sentence, delete "as a direct final rule without prior proposal because."
