OPP held 5 meetings with the industry group AdvaMed between September 2023 and May 2024 to discuss AdvaMed's public comments on the EtO Proposed Interim Decision (PID), and to inform the mitigation in the EtO Interim Decision (ID). AdvaMed has over 400 membership companies who represent the medical industry.

September 11, 2023

Discussed the public comments AdvaMed had submitted on the EtO Proposed Interim Decision (PID), particularly AdvaMed's concerns for the medical device supply chain.
