On November 20, 2024, you signed the Proposed Rule entitled, *West Virginia Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program; Class VI Primacy*, EPA-HQ-OW-2024-0357; FRL 12000-01-OW. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency then transmitted the rule to the Office of Federal Register for publication. We have made the following changes to the public comment period and information related to the public hearing. We made additional non-substantive edits requested by the Office of Federal Register. The EPA does not intend to publish a document in the Federal Register announcing updates.

The EPA will begin pre-registering speakers for the hearing upon publication of this document in the *Federal Register*. The EPA will make every effort to follow the schedule as closely as possible on the day of the hearing; however, please plan for the hearings to run either ahead of schedule or behind schedule. Additionally, requests to speak will be taken the day of the hearing at the hearing registration desk. The EPA will make every effort to accommodate all speakers who arrive and register, although preferences on speaking times may not be able to be fulfilled.

The EPA encourages commenters to provide the EPA with a copy of their oral testimony electronically by emailing it to *WVClassVI@epa.gov*. The EPA also recommends submitting the text of your oral comments as written comments to the rulemaking docket.

The EPA may ask clarifying questions during the oral presentations but will not respond to the presentations at that time. Written statements and supporting information submitted during the comment period will be considered with the same weight as oral comments and supporting information presented at the public hearing.

The EPA will not provide audiovisual equipment for presentations unless we receive special requests in advance. Commenters should notify Himanshu Vyas when they pre-register to speak that they will need specific equipment. If you require the services of an interpreter or special accommodations such as audio description, please pre-register for the hearing with Himanshu Vyas and describe your needs by <u>December 23, 2024January</u> 2, 2025. The EPA may not be able to arrange accommodations without advance notice.
