The National Air Pollution Control Techniques Advisory Committee (NAPCTAC) will meet on July 11 and 12, 1978, to review the standards support and environmental impact statements for the control of arsenic emissions from process sources for copper smelters, organic emissions from charging and topside leaks for coke ovens, and particulate matter from non-metallic minerals processing plants. The agenda will also include status reports on this Division's work on the following items: glass manufacturing plants, internal combustion engines, the new source performance standards priority list, and the revision to the power plants standard. An agenda giving the location and times of the various discussions is enclosed.

The NAPCTAC meetings are always open, and you are invited to attend and participate in the discussions. The documents on particulate matter from non-metallic minerals processing plants which will be discussed at the meeting were previously mailed to you. The meeting will be announced in the Federal Register; but we wanted you to have this additional information because of your interest in these regulations.

In order to properly plan the meeting, it is necessary for me to know prior to the meeting if you plan to make a presentation. If you do make a presentation, please bring three copies to the meeting for our use in preparing the meeting minutes. If you plan to make a presentation or would like additional information on the meeting, please call Mrs. Mary Jane Clark (919 541-6271) by July 5. Written comments are certainly welcome, and we can schedule a meeting with your association to discuss your comments if you so desire.
