On January 12, 2022, the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Board approved amendments to Shelby County Health Department's portion of the State Implementation Plan, which incorporated portions of Tennessee's Chapter 1200-03-20. This rule change was submitted to U.S. EPA on March 1, 2022, as a revision to Tennessee's State Implementation Plan.

Following conversations with EPA Region 4 and the evaluation of the potential approvability findings, Shelby County Health Department, through the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control hereby withdraws the revisions to the changes to Rule 1200-3-20 as indicated in the attached memo from the Shelby County Health Department.
