SUBJECT: September 17, 2024, Call with Utah Manufacturers Association Regarding the Utah Air Plan Partial Approval and Partial Disapproval, Proposed Rule, 89 Fed. Reg. 67208 (August 19, 2024)

This memo summarizes the September 17, 2024 call between representatives for the Utah Manufacturers Association (UMA) and EPA Region 8. The purpose of the call was for UMA to discuss their concerns with the proposed rule. UMA stated that the Utah state implementation plan (SIP) should be approved, and that if not fully approved, EPA should be clear regarding which parts of the SIP are approved and which are disapproved. UMA also stated that Senate Bill 161 does not implicate the SIP. The UMA representatives stated that they intended to submit their concerns in writing during the comment period.
