Subject: Regional Haze SIP Revision for Massachusetts – clarification

Dear Ms. Hamjian:

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) hereby submits a redacted version of the plan approval for Canal Station restricting fuel sulfur content for EU1 to 0.3% that was submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on June 15, 2022 as a supplement to the Massachusetts Regional Haze State Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision for the Second Implementation Period (2018-2028). The redacted version has unnecessary provisions struck out to clarify MassDEP's intent to only incorporate into the Regional Haze SIP revision the fuel sulfur limit and associated provisions of the plan approval necessary to monitor and enforce that limit.
