All public comments received are subject to the Freedom of Information Act and will be posted in their entirety at regulations.gov, including any personal and/or business confidential information provided. Do not include any information you would not like to be made publicly available.

Written public comments should be respectful and relevant to the topics, questions, and work products posted for comment. All comments are reviewed by the government before they are released to the public to ensure they align with this public comment policy. Comments that include the following will not be publicly released:

- Vulgar, obscene, profane, threatening, or abusive language; personal attacks of any kind
- Discriminatory language (including hate speech) based on race, national origin, age, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or disability
- Endorsements of commercial products or services
- Repetitive posts (for example, if you submit the same material multiple times)
- Spam or undecipherable language (gratuitous links will be viewed as spam)
- Copyrighted material of which the respondent is not the sole author or owner of, or does not have the right to use
- Links to irrelevant external sites, including those with suspected nefarious or obscene content
- Solicitation of funds
- Procurement-sensitive information
- Surveys, polls, and questionnaires subject to the Office of Management and Budget Paperwork Reduction Act clearance
- Personally Identifiable Information (PII) or Sensitive Information (SI)
- Off-topic posts
- Media inquiries
