Re: Final Submittal; Proposed Revision to State Implementation Plan – Rule 62-296.513, F.A.C., Surface Coating of Miscellaneous Metal Parts and Products Rule Amendments

Dear Mr. Blackman:

In accordance with 40 C.F.R. 51.103, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) requests approval of a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for Rule 62-296.513, F.A.C., Air Pollution Control – Surface Coating of Miscellaneous Metal Parts and Products Rule Amendments.

On August 31, 2022, the Department published in the Florida Administrative Register a notice of opportunity to submit comments regarding this proposed SIP revision, request a public hearing, or participate in a public hearing on October 5, 2022, if requested. No hearing was requested, and no hearing was held. This process met the public participation requirements of 40 C.F.R. 51.102.

The rule language that DEP is requesting be amended in Florida's SIP is contained in Rule 62-296.513, F.A.C. ("Surface Coating of Miscellaneous Metal Parts and Products [MMPP]"). This proposed SIP revision consists of amendments providing compliance alternatives to the MMPP requirements for aerospace parts and products coating operations by cross-referencing the requirements of the federal National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart GG ("National Emission Standards for Aerospace Manufacturing and Rework Facilities"), which Florida has adopted by reference in Rule 62-204.800, F.A.C. Florida's proposed SIP revision also includes the required CAA Section 110(l) noninterference demonstration.
