I did have one question relating to the benefits calculations in the RIA which I'm hoping you can help answer (or direct me to someone else on your team who can help).

I noted that the benefits in the RIA are reported in millions of 2017\$.

I noted that the attached TSD provided the VSL used in the calculation of the monetized benefits in 2015\$ (first row of Table 21).

I attempted to look in the RIA but did not see the corresponding VSL value in 2017\$ (with 3% and 7% discount rates). Is this reported somewhere or can this be backed out somehow using the information in the RIA? Thanks again for your help.
