What Is the Purpose of Form G-1607NO?

Form G-1607NO, USCIS Adult Citizenship Educator of the Year (ACEY), is used to nominate an individual for ACEY.

Who May Use Form G-1607NO?

Individuals wishing to nominate a person in their organization to be a U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services Adult Educator of the Year (ACEY).

General Instructions

All Nominees must have at least 3 years' experience of instructing adult students in citizenship or English as a Second Language (ESL). The Nominee also must be a Lawful Permanent Resident (LPR) or U.S. citizen at the time of nomination.
