On February 7, 2013, the U.S. EPA promulgated 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart CCCC - New Source Performance Standards and Subpart DDDD - Emission Guidelines for Commercial and Industrial Solid Waste Incineration Units. This letter certifies that Maine currently does not have any units subject to either the New Source Performance Standard (Subpart CCCC) or the Emission Guidelines (Subpart DDDD). Maine submits this negative declaration to serve in lieu of a state plan pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 62.06.

If, in the future, an affected existing source is located within the state's jurisdiction, Maine will develop and submit a state plan with requirements as stringent as those in 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart DDDD.
