Meeting Summary

On April 24, 2024, representatives from EPA met with iGPS, a company that specializes in plastic shipping pallet rentals, to discuss EPA's 2023 proposed regulation for decaBDE. Specifically, the discussion focused on the proposed labeling requirement for plastic pallets that are known to contain decaBDE. iGPS opposes the proposed labeling requirements, which would require iGPS to label plastic shipping pallets that contain decaBDE. iGPS provided an overview presentation, marked as Confidential Business Information (CBI), which discussed their concerns with the costs of labeling plastic pallets that contain decaBDE. iGPS also summarized their comments on the 2023 Proposed decaBDE rule provisions, providing support for the proposed use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and workplace protection measures in areas where pallets containing decaBDE are being recycled. A non-CBI presentation and supporting letter are attached.
