MT. OLIVER MAN WITH MULTIPLE WARRANTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Mt. Oliver man with multiple warrants has been taken into custody.

28-year-old Leroy Miller has been on the run from Mt. Oliver police for the past 3 years with active warrants for 2 cases. The first case involves a simple assault charge in which he is accused of striking his girlfriend in the face during an altercation. The second active warrant involves a number of charges including aggravated assault in which a female victim told police that Miller struck her in the head with a clothes iron and then choked her. Additionally, Miller has an active bench warrant from Family Court charging him with direct criminal contempt for failing to appear in January of this year.

This week, detectives from our office developed information that Miller was staying at a residence on Hanna Street in Braddock. When detectives arrived at the address earlier today, they were greeted by an individual who said he was Miller's brother. When detectives advised of the active warrants for Leroy Miller, they were allowed to enter the residence. Detectives issued commands to the second floor of the residence and Leroy Miller came down from the second floor, was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
