DUQUESNE MAN WITH MULTIPLE BENCH AND ACTIVE WARRANTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Duquesne man with multiple bench and active warrants has been taken into custody.

31-year-old Nicholas Lomax has been a fugitive since July of this year when bench warrants were issued in Allegheny and Westmoreland counties for probation violations. Additionally, Lomax has 2 active warrants out of Monroeville involving fleeing police and a strangulation charge and a warrant out of Duquesne for terroristic threats.

Detectives from our office were in the Hill District this morning when they encountered two individuals on Dinwiddie Street. They subsequently learned that the individuals were waiting to give Lomax a ride. The detectives made entry into a nearby house, arrested Lomax without incident, and transported him to the Allegheny County Jail.
