PLEASANT HILLS MAN WANTED FOR ROBBERY AND AGGRAVATED ASSAULT TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Pleasant Hills man, wanted in connection with a robbery and aggravated assault earlier this month, has been taken into custody.

Pittsburgh Police issued an arrest warrant for 33-year-old Brandon Domer following a confrontation on September 7th at Legends Bar on Brownsville Road. The victim told police that Domer asked him to step outside of the bar and then produced a knife, pushing the knife against his neck and stomach while threatening the victim's life. The victim handed over \$600.00 cash to Domer after which Domer fled the scene.

Detectives from our office developed information this week that Domer was staying with his girlfriend on Pleasant Street in South Park. When they approached the residence earlier today, detectives located Domer sitting in a car. Domer was then arrested without incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.

Domer is facing arraignment on a number of charges including felony robbery and felony aggravated assault.
