McKEESPORT MAN WITH MULTIPLE WARRANTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a McKeesport man with multiple warrants has been taken into custody.

29-year-old James Pamplin has been a fugitive since May of this year when a bench warrant was issued concerning a probation violation connected to a 2022 guilty plea to aggravated assault. Additionally, he has 2 active warrants out of McKeesport, both involving simple assault charges, and a warrant from Family Court.

Detectives from our office developed information this week that Pamplin was inside of a residence on Scott Street in McKeesport. When detectives approached the residence on Thursday, the door was open at which point they entered and began to search the residence. Pamplin attempted to evade the detectives by hiding in the basement, but eventually complied with the commands to show himself.

Following the arrest, Pamplin was transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
