McKEESPORT MAN PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF AGGRAVATED ASSAULT TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a McKeesport man who had previously pleaded guilty to aggravated assault and a firearms violation has been arrested on two warrants.

22-year-old Michael Singleton pleaded guilty to the charges in 2022 and was sentenced to time served and probation with additional probation ordered earlier this year. Singleton has been a fugitive since September when a bench warrant was issued for violation of that probation. Additionally, Singleton has a current active warrant out of McKeesport for two firearms violations after he was found to be in possession of a handgun while a passenger in a vehicle that was stopped by police.

Our detectives this week developed information that Singleton was staying at the residence of a friend in North Versailles. When detectives approached the location along Greensburg Pike this morning, Singleton's friend answered the door, after which Singleton responded to commands, was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
