BRADDOCK MAN WITH HISTORY OF FIREARMS VIOLATIONS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Braddock man with a history of firearms violations has been taken into custody.

26-year-old Tremond Alston has been a fugitive since June of this year when a bench warrant was issued for a probation violation connected to a 2021 guilty plea to numerous charges including firearms violations, terroristic threats and DUI. Alston is also facing two active warrants for new firearms related charges out of the City of Pittsburgh and Duquesne.

Detectives this week developed information that Alston was staying with the mother of his child on Mapleview Drive in Braddock. When detectives arrived at the house Wednesday morning, Alston attempted to exit the residence from a second-floor window. Alston was taken into custody without further incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
