## **Barnes County DUI Crash**

**What:** Three Vehicle Property Crash.

**Where:** Interstate 94 eastbound MM 283 (3 miles southeast of Sanborn, ND).

**When:** September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 8:39 PM Central Time.

**Road Conditions:** Wet

**Weather Conditions:** Cloudy

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle.

**Type of Crash:** Wrong way driver-sideswipe

**Agencies Involved:** North Dakota Highway Patrol, Barnes County Sheriff's Department. Valley City Fire.

**Vehicle No. 1:** 2017 Ford Escape

**Driver No. 1:** Skyler Holub- 39-year-old male from Jamestown, ND (Not injured).

**Restraints:** seatbelt.

**Charges:** Driving Under the Influence of alcohol. Reckless Endangerment.

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2014 Ford Econoline U-Haul Truck

**Driver No. 2:** Kory Russell- 40-year-old male from Valley City, ND (Not Injured).

**Restraints:** seatbelt

**Charges:** no charges

**Vehicle No. 3:** 1996 Buick Century

**Driver No. 3:** Peyton Glassic- 32-year-old male from Shohomish, WA (Not Injured)

**Restraints:** seatbelt

**Charges:** no charges

**NARRATIVE:** On September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at approximately 8:39 PM a three-vehicle property crash occurred on Interstate 94 eastbound near MM 283, due to a wrong way vehicle driving westbound in the eastbound lanes of travel.

(Skyler Holub) was operating a Ford Escape traveling westbound in the eastbound lane of travel. A U-Haul truck operated by (Kory Russel), and a Buick Century operated by (Peyton Glassic), were traveling eastbound in the correct lanes of travel. Both observed the wrong way driving Ford Escape and took evasive action. These evasive actions avoided a head on collision with the Ford Escape.

The Ford Escape struck both vehicles in a side-swipe collision. The Ford Escape then entered the south ditch of Interstate 94 coming to rest in the ditch. No one was injured in the crash.

The wrong way driver Skyler Holub was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol and reckless endangerment. This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
