Billings County Serious Injury/Fatal Crash

Where: Hwy 85 Milepost 92; 1 mile north of Fairfield

When: July 17, 2024; 2:40 pm Mountain

Road Conditions: Normal

Weather Conditions: Sunny, clear.

Crash Involvement: Vehicle vs Vehicle

Type of Crash: Head-on collision

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Billings County Sheriff's Department, Billings County

Fire/Rescue, Belfield Ambulance

Vehicle No. 1: 2019 white Ford Edge

Driver No. 1: Female; 41 yr. old; Watford City, ND; fatal injuries

Restraints: Unknown **Charges:** none

Vehicle No. 2: 2012 red Western Star truck

Driver No. 2: Male; 50 yr. old; Cleburn, TX; serious injury

Restraints: Seat belt **Charges:** none

NARRATIVE: Vehicle 1 was southbound on Hwy 85 at milepost 92. Vehicle Two was northbound at the same location. Driver 1 lost control of the Ford Edge, left her lane and collided head-on with the Western Star semi-truck in the northbound lane. A fire ignited due to the crash and burned up both vehicles. Driver 1 sustained fatal injuries in the crash. Driver 2 sustained serious injuries and was flown to an emergency room in Bismarck. This crash is still under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
