## \*Updated\* Stutsman County injury crash \*Name Release\*

**What:** Two vehicle injury crash

Where: Southbound US Highway 52 & 32<sup>nd</sup> St (2 miles north of Jamestown, ND)

When: September 23, 2024 at 4:42 P.M. Central Time

Road Conditions: Dry asphalt

Weather Conditions: Partly Cloudy

**Crash Involvement:** Pickup struck SUV- angle

## **Narrative:**



Curtis Maki was driving a Hyundai Palisade southbound on US Highway 281 approaching the intersection of 32nd St SE. At this time the driver of the Ram, Robert Aleman, was westbound on 32nd St SE approaching the same intersection. Robert Aleman entered the intersection striking the Hyundai on the front driver side of the vehicle. Both vehicles left the roadway and came to rest in the southwest ditch on their wheels.

All three individuals sustained serious but non-life-threatening injuries because of the crash. The Jamestown Ambulance treated and transported all involved to the Jamestown Regional Medical Center for further care.

The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
