Ward County Injury Crash

Where: Highway 2 Mile Marker 128, approximately 16 miles West of Minot

When: May 21, 2024, approximately 10:42 AM CT

Road Conditions: Dry

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Single Vehicle

Type of Crash: Rollover

Agencies Involved: NDHP, Ward County Sheriff's Office, Burlington PD, Minot Community Ambulance, Berthold Fire/EMS

Vehicle No. 1: 2000 Sterling Dump Truck

Driver No. 1: Jeffrey Krout, 60 years old, Towner, ND, Serious injuries

Restraints: Seatbelt not used

Charges: Under investigation

NARRATIVE: On May 21st, 2024, at approximately 10:42 am, a single vehicle injury crash occurred approximately 16 miles west of Minot on Highway 2 near mile marker 128. A 2000 Sterling Dump Truck being driven by Jeffrey Krout was hauling a load of asphalt westbound on Highway 2 near mile marker 128. The front left steer tire blew out causing the dump truck to enter the median and cross the eastbound lanes of Highway 2. The dump truck entered the south ditch and overturned. Krout sustained serious injuries and was transported to Trinity Hospital in Minot. Asphalt crews cleared the eastbound lanes which were covered by asphalt.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
