Where: Near intersection of 130th Rd NW and 48th St NW, approximately 3 miles SE of

Williston

NARRATIVE: A 2007 Peterbilt truck was northbound on 130th Rd NW just north of the intersection of 48th St NW. The Peterbilt drove off the roadway right and steered left in attempt to correct back onto the road. The Peterbilt rolled multiple times and came to rest on its top. The driver, Briot Nehring sustained serious, life-threatening injuries and was transported CHI Williston by Williston Ambulance Services. The driver was later flown to Trinity Health in Minot where he succumbed to his injuries. The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
