UPDATEState Street DUI Injury Crash in Bismarck

What: Injury

Where: State Street in Bismarck in front of Heritage Center

When: 8/04/2024 at 3:15 PM CDT

Road Conditions: Good

Weather Conditions: Cloudy

Crash Involvement: Vehicle

Type of Crash: Non-Collision 1 vehicle crash

Agencies Involved: ND Highway Patrol, Bismarck Fire, Metro Area Ambulance, Bismarck PD

Vehicle No. 1: 2003 Chevrolet Trail Blazer

Driver No. 1: Antonio Garcia, 28-year-old male from Bismarck, no injury

Restraints: not in use

Charges: Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with minor, Reckless Driving, Driving

Under Suspension, Child Neglect

Passenger No. 1: Tabitha White Eagle, 34-year-old female from Bismarck, no injury

Restraints: not in use

Passenger No. 2: 6-year-old male juvenile from Bismarck, minor injury

Restraints: not in use

NARRATIVE: Chevy Trailblazer was traveling southbound on State Street in Bismarck at a high rate of speed. Driver, Antonio Garcia, lost control of the vehicle and drove off the roadway crashing into the west ditch across from the Heritage Center. Juvenile in vehicle was transported to Sanford Hospital for minor injury. Garcia was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with minor present. Male juvenile was not restrained in seatbelt or child restraint system at time of crash. Garcia is also charged with reckless driving,
