Type of Crash: Motorcycle/Deer

Vehicle No. 1: 2010 Triumph RS

Driver No. 1: George Midboe; Male; 69 years old; Inkster, ND; serious injuries

Restraints: Helmet worn

NARRATIVE:

The Triumph was northbound on North Dakota Highway 32 when a deer entered the roadway from the west and struck the Triumph. The driver maintained control and the Triumph came to rest in the northbound lane of travel.

The driver was transported by Park River Ambulance Service to Altru Hospital in Grand Forks.
