NARRATIVE: A 2014 Ford F-150 and a 2017 GMC Sierra were driving southbound in the left lane of Hwy 83 near mile marker 187. Troopers were investigating a property crash that occurred earlier at the same location. Traffic was directed to the left southbound lane. The Ford F-150 being driven by Tyler Bradshaw slowed but was then struck in the rear by GMC Sierra which was following behind it. The GMC Sierra was driven by Richard Jackson. The GMC Sierra came to rest in the middle of the road and the Ford F-150 came to rest on the median edge of the left lane. June Yellow Lodge, a passenger in the GMC Sierra was injured and transported to Trinity Hospital in Minot. The crash caused the southbound lanes of Highway 83 to be shut down for approximately 30 minutes. The names of the juveniles will not be released.

The crash remains under investigation by the NDHP.
