Motorcycle Injury Crash – June 26th – West Fargo

What: Fatal motorcycle crash

Where: 3400 block Sheyenne Street South, West Fargo ND

Driver No. 1:, Douglas Neve, 33, Fargo, ND – fatal injuries

NARRATIVE:

The 2016 Indian Motorcycle, driven by Neve, was southbound in the 3400 block of Sheyenne Street South and was traveling in lane one. The motorcycle struck and drove over the median curb, entering the grassy median. The motorcycle then sideswiped a light pole in the median, which caused the motorcycle to overturn onto its side. Neve was thrown from the bike and sustained serious life-threatening injuries. The motorcycle and Neve both came to rest in lane two of southbound Sheyenne Street.



Neve was transported via ambulance to Sanford Hospital on June 26th. On June 30th, Neve died from the injuries he sustained in the crash while in Sanford Hospital.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol
