Vehicle vs. Bicycle Injury Crash - Update

What: Serious Injury Crash

Where: 25th Street S and 40th Avenue S, Fargo

When: 9/10/24 9:32 AM CST

Crash involvement: Vehicle/Bicyclist

Type of Crash: L Angle

Agencies Involved: North Dakota Highway Patrol, Fargo Police Department, Sanford

Vehicle No. 1: 2023 Ford F-150

Driver No. 1: Bing Zhang, 49-year-old male, Fargo, ND, not injured

Restraints: Seat belt in use **Charges:** No charges

Vehicle No. 2: *Specialized* Bicycle

Driver No. 1: Jay Holding Eagle, 66-year-old male, Fargo, ND; Serious/life-threatening

injuries

Restraints: No helmet **Charges:** No charges

NARRATIVE:

The Ford F150 was eastbound on 40th Ave S turning left onto 25th Street S. The bicyclist entered the crosswalk westbound. The Ford struck the bicycle/bicyclist. The bicyclist was thrown from the bike, sustaining serious, life-threatening injuries and was transported to a local hospital by Sanford Ambulance.



The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
